Snacks

Up to 35 families stay each day at the Ronald McDonald House, and thanks to donors and volunteers, they are comforted by food available in our kitchen. They enjoy individually packaged homemade items (two cookies in a ziploc bag, a small bag of trail mix, muffins/brownies in plastic wrap) - though being individually packaged is not a requirement. Due to the number of families we serve, we can always use many snacks, so there is no limit (or minimum) to the amount of snacks prepared.

All time spent shopping for items, preparing the product at your home and delivering them to the Ronald McDonald House can be counted as service hours. Please have any forms needed ready to go (with completed volunteer hours) and any manager on duty can sign them for service hours. Items can be dropped off when the office is open: Monday – Friday 9am to 9pm, Saturday 9am to 2pm and Sunday 2pm to 9pm. This project is open to all ages and does not require an application.

Join us to help fold linens, make deliveries to the Family Room, organize donations, clean and more! This opportunity is available each Tuesday night from 5:30 – 7:30pm and open to the first 10 responders each week. This opportunity is a one-time commitment which may be repeated as desired.
